Student registration enhancements	Enhancements to student registration refine the process for finding student matches in Aspen (and avoid duplicate student records). These enhancements allow you to:
	 Customize the display of registration matches in the Student Registration wizard with a new preference in the Membership category. The matching students' names appear in a pick list for the registrar to review, along with the fields specified here.
	 Limit the display of registration matches in the Student Registration wizard through new strict search criteria, specified in the <u>Root Organization's Membership</u> <u>preferences</u>. You can determine whether to return exact matches to the last name, gender, and date of birth entered, and/or matches for birth dates within 45 days of the birth date entered.
	 Specify required sibling search criteria for registrars when they enroll a student who is related to an active student. The search criteria are selected in a new <u>Root</u> <u>Organization Membership preference</u>.

	 View an enhanced alert when attempting to enroll a student who is already active in the district. The alert appears in the Student Registration wizard and lists the student's name, some limited demographic data, and contact information for the student's school and district. 	
	 Create a former school association record when a student withdraws, if specified in the <u>Root Organization's Membership preference</u>. 	
Student Demographic Change widget	As a School view user, the new Student Changes widget gives you a quick way to see changes to your students' demographic information. Choose to view changes made that day, or over the past seven, 30, or 60 days. Each row in the widget displays the student's LASID and name, as well as the field that was changed, date and time of the change, and the name of the person who changed the student record. Click on an entry in the widget to see more detailed information, including the field's previous and current values (School view, Pages).	
Cross-enrollment features	Enhancements to cross-enrollment make it easier for schools to manage and track students who take classes or receive services at more than one school, a primary school and one or more secondary schools. The new features include:	
	 Two new Root Organization preferences determine how students become associated with their secondary schools. 	
	 A new cross-enrollment alert 2 appears on student details pages, on the Student List (if the Alerts column is in the field set) and in the gradebook score grid. Clicking provides details of the student's cross-enrollments. 	
	• A report lists the cross-enrolled students within a specified date range for school users. The user determines whether to print all of their primary students who are cross-enrolled at other schools, all of their secondary students (primary enrollments at other schools), or all cross-enrollments (both groups).	

	 A new student status, Active No Primary, indicates a student has withdrawn from his or her primary school but remains active at a secondary school. When a user attempts to enroll a student with this status in the Student Registration wizard, an informational pop-up appears indicating the student's status and listing contact information for the secondary school.
New Current Members filter	The new Current Members filter enables schools to see active students as of today's date (School view, Student). The filter excludes students with a future enrollment date or who

have been withdrawn from the current school.

Schedulers (For Aspen users who build and manage school and student schedules)

Calendars	Root Organization administrators can now give Intermediate Organizations the ability to initialize calendars for themselves and their schools and staff with a <u>new General</u> <u>preference</u> . Also, in the Calendar Initialization wizard, a new Initialize schools checkbox lets users initialize a calendar for all of their schools at one time, or select just a subset of the schools listed.
Course catalogs	Root Organizations and Intermediate Organizations gain support for managing their course catalogs.
	 Root Organization users can determine whether course attributes are owned by the Root Organization or Intermediate Organization and can restrict courses from Intermediate Organizations.
	 Intermediate Organization users determine whether course attributes are owned by their organization or their schools, and can restrict courses from individual schools.
	Schools can edit course attributes designated as school-owned.

	These specifications are pushed down from the Root Organization to the Intermediate Organization and from the Intermediate Organization to the schools through <u>Schedule</u> <u>preferences</u> .

Select a class, and click Trends on the Class Trends side-tab. Staff view, Attendance > Class . Select a class and click Trends on the Class side-tab).
Daily Absence alert	The Daily Absence alert ^I indicates that a student was marked absent for all or part of a day. The alert appears:

	Clicking 🏝 displays details such as the date and the attendance code entered when daily

attendance was taken. A Class Absence(s) section appears if your school takes class attendance and a student has at least one class attendance absence record for the current day. It shows the period number, class name, number, and attendance code for each period the student was marked absent.

Added Functionality for Intermediate Organization Users

Aspen's 5.1 release offers several enhancements to Intermediate Organization users, including several that were previously only available to Root Organization level users. Some enhancements are also available to schools. The new enhancements affect:

Roles management	Administrators at the Intermediate Organization level can now create, delete, and modify security roles for users associated with their organization. (Intermediate Organization view, Admin > Roles .)	
Qualification Lists	Qualification lists are a way to search for and list students who meet one or more grade criteria. Intermediate Organization users can now manage their own Qualification Lists (Intermediate Organization view, Grades > Qualification Lists) . They can:	
	 add, edit, and delete Qualification Lists owned by their organization. 	
	 review Qualification Lists owned by the Root Organization, but they cannot modify or delete them. 	
	Root Organization users can view an Intermediate Organization's Qualification Lists by using an Intermediate Organization-level view.	
GPA definitions	Intermediate Organization users can now create and modify their own GPA definitions (Intermediate Organization view, Grades > GPA) and:	
	 add, edit, and delete GPA definitions owned by their organization. 	
	 review GPA definitions owned by the Root Organization, but they cannot modify or delete them.
